Pierco double wax frames cost an extra 25 cents each but are supposed to have better comb draw by the bees.

I have gathered equipment that I feel every beekeeper can use so that he can produce honey. The prices for the kits come out to be approximately what you would pay from Betterbee, unassembled without shipping and you get them right here on the island. To make it cost effective for me to do this and pay my expenses, I need to be efficient in delivery. Therefore, orders need to be placed and I will set up a time when it can be picked up. I realize that emergencies happen with swarms but please be patient or expect to give me a big tip. :-). I am only offering what I use in my apiary so I do not offer wooden frames. Boxes are assembled with glue and nails. Equipment Discount 5% in kits. Bees (Nucs) may be available for most of the spring and summer but call or email for price and availability.

These kits are just wooden ware and frames. It is expected that you will pick up the individual beekeeping extras from a regular bee supplier. This just provides a lower cost alternative by providing assembled equipment at unassembled prices, the best frames in the industry (in my opinion) and delivered to Long Island.

Basic Kit - This is the absolute minimum equipment list to start with bees this year. It is composed of Bottom Board/varroa screen, Inner Cover, Outer Cover, a single deep box and three medium boxes with plastic frames having double beeswax coating for better bee acceptance. With the Deep box, you can get either Nuc or package bees to start and in case of problem, you can swap a standard brood frame with another beekeeper to restart a failing hive. The medium boxes provide honey storage room for the heaviest flow years and allow you to use one as an expansion brood chamber for winter food storage.

Deluxe Kit - This kit expands upon the Basic kit to provide equipment to allow you to deal with most possible situations that can arise in the first year and even future years with bees. It adds a second, backup set of Bottom Board/varroa screen, Inner Cover, Outer Cover, and a single deep box with plastic frames. With the second Deep box, have a swarm if you get one this year, which has happened with first year bees even though more common in the second year. After swarming season is done or if you recognize that your bees are preparing to swarm, you can start a Nuc from your original hive as a backup or a replacement queen. Later, if you never have need of the nuc and don't want to increase your hive count, you can combine it with the original hive or sell it to someone else who has a need. Alternatively, if it strong enough, you can try to winter it for insurance against loss of the other hive.

Shallow Kit - This kit provides the same room and capability of the Basic kit to absolute minimum equipment list to start with bees this year, using all medium equipment to keep individual box weight down. You can use a nuc in medium boxes but it is generally inconvenient, so go with the package. Minimum brood area is two medium boxes but a third can be used to expand the brood nest for winter stores.

Deluxe Shallow Kit - This kit expands upon the basic Shallow Kit, just like the Deluxe Kit, to provide equipment to allow you to deal with most possible situations that can arise in the first year and even future years with bees, but still in medium boxes. It adds a second, backup set of Bottom Board/varroa screen, Inner Cover, Outer Cover, and a single deep box with plastic frames. With one of the medium boxes, have a swarm if you get one this year. After swarming season is done or if you recognize that your bees are preparing to swarm, you can start a Nuc from your original hive as a backup or a replacement queen. Later, if you never have need of the nuc and don't want to increase your hive count, you can combine it with the original hive or sell it to someone else who has a need. Alternatively, if it strong enough, you can try to winter it for insurance against loss of the other hive.

Standard Deep Hive Kit - This is the old standard expansion method, with two deep boxes for brood and three supers.
